### **File Format**

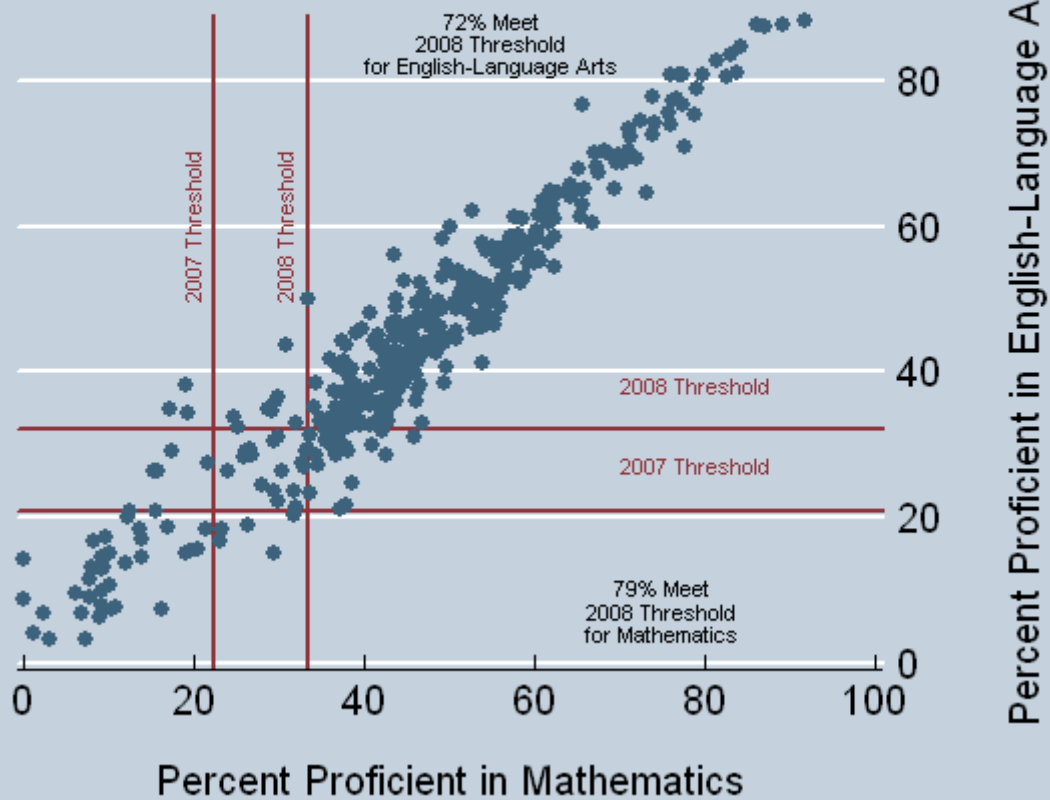
Each figure will come in a tif file format. TIFF files can be inserted easily into word processing programs and used in graphics programs. The files are named in an easily-identifiable manner and will include your CDS code to allow district administrators to distinguish between schools easily.

Note the sample figures below for *Mathematics*. The package includes figures for both English and Mathematics. Each package will have up to forty-four unique figures depending on the number of subgroups in the school. Most schools will receive twenty-five to thirty figures.

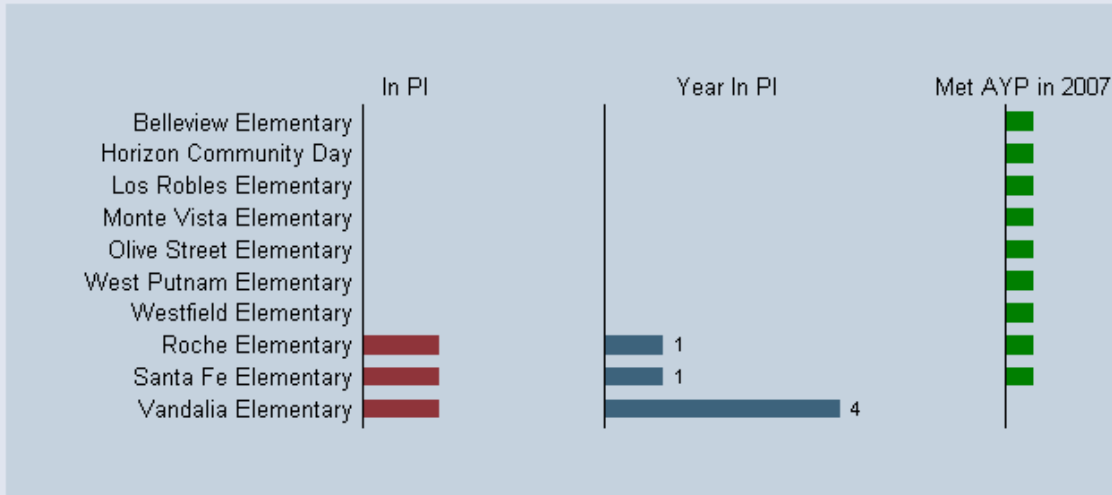

## Program Improvement Status Sunrise Unified, Elementary Schools 2007-08

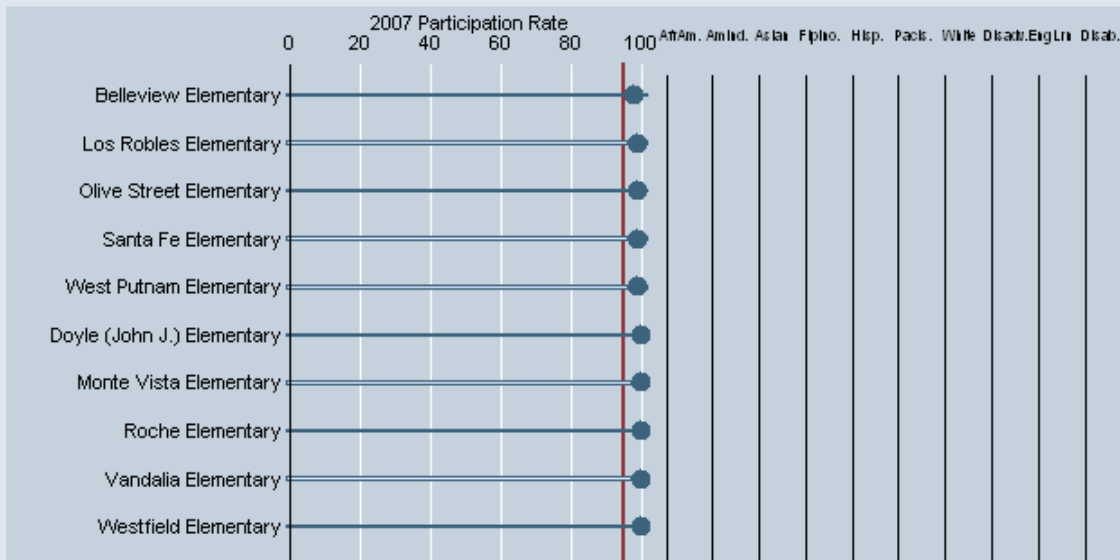

A school must make Adequate Yearly Progress for two consecutive years to exit Program Improvement. Schools in 'Year 1' Program Improvement are positioned to exit if they make adequate progress in the coming year.

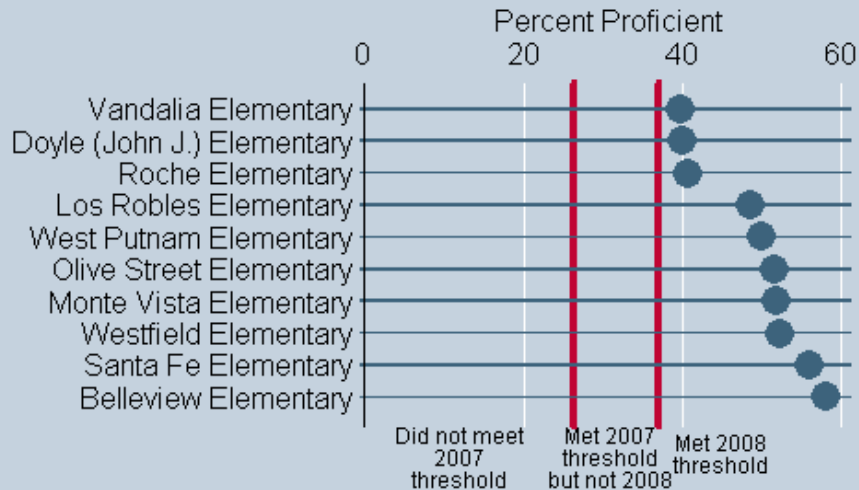

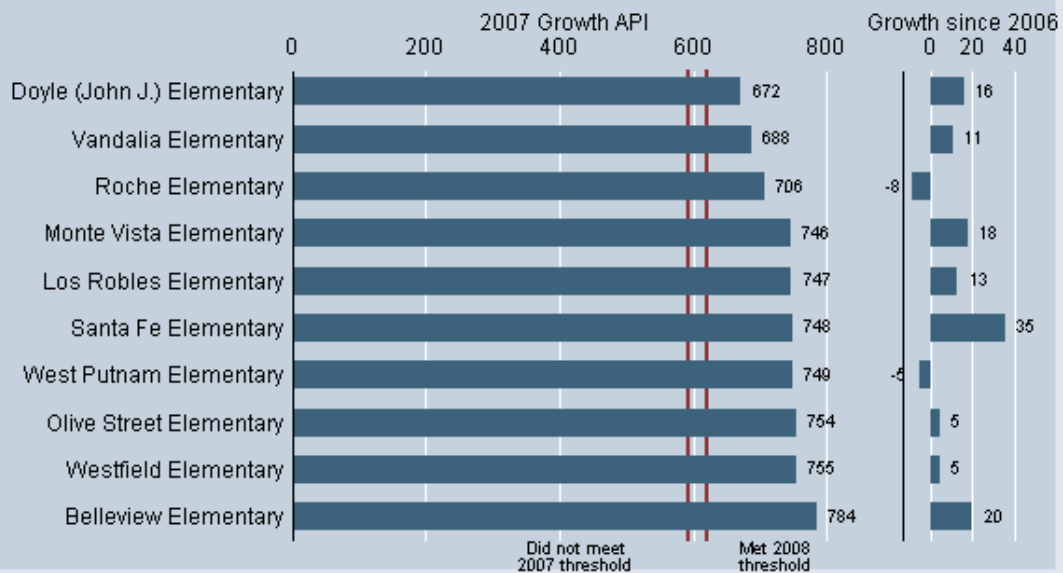

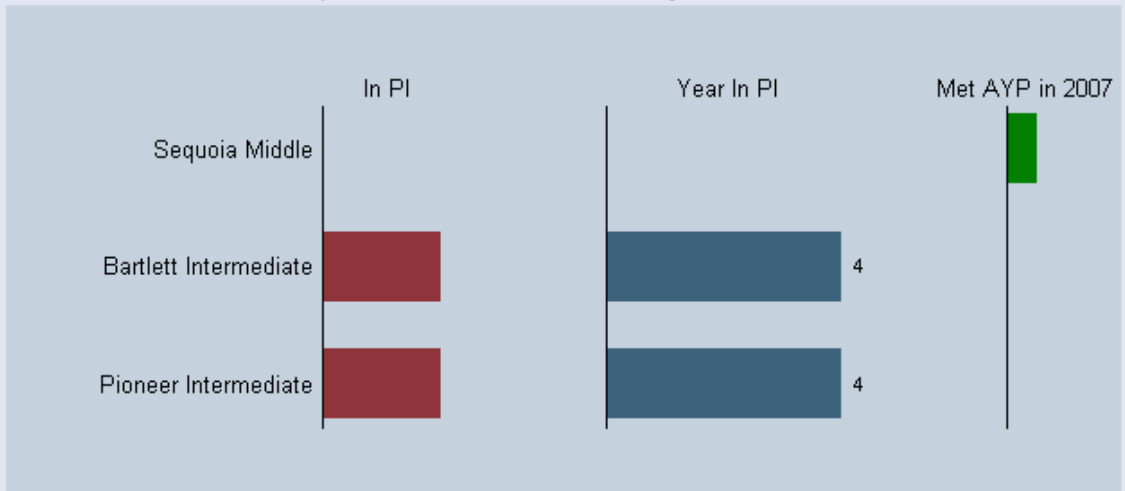
## Mathematics Percent Proficient 2007 Sunrise Unified, Elementary Schools

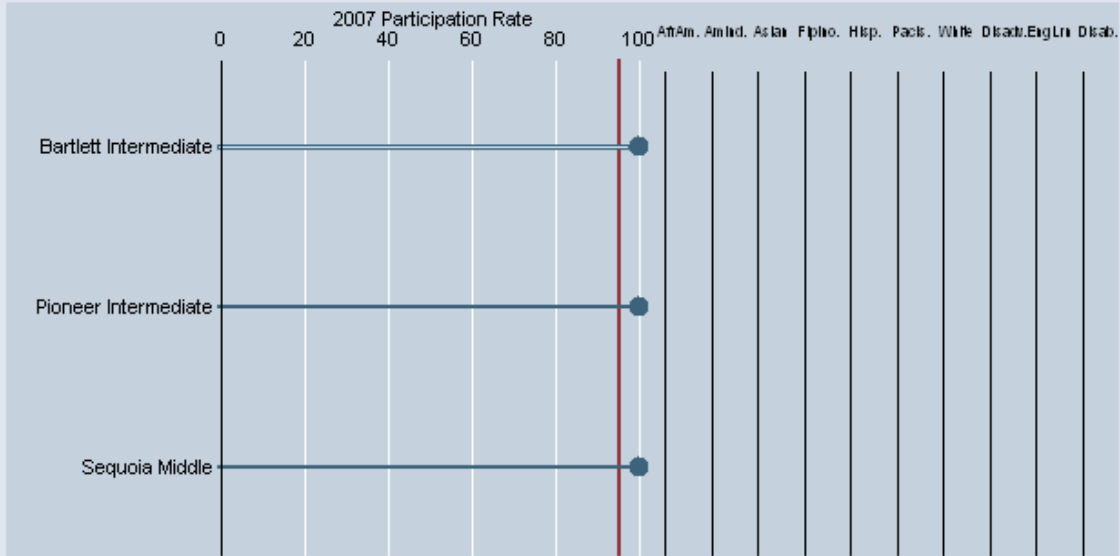

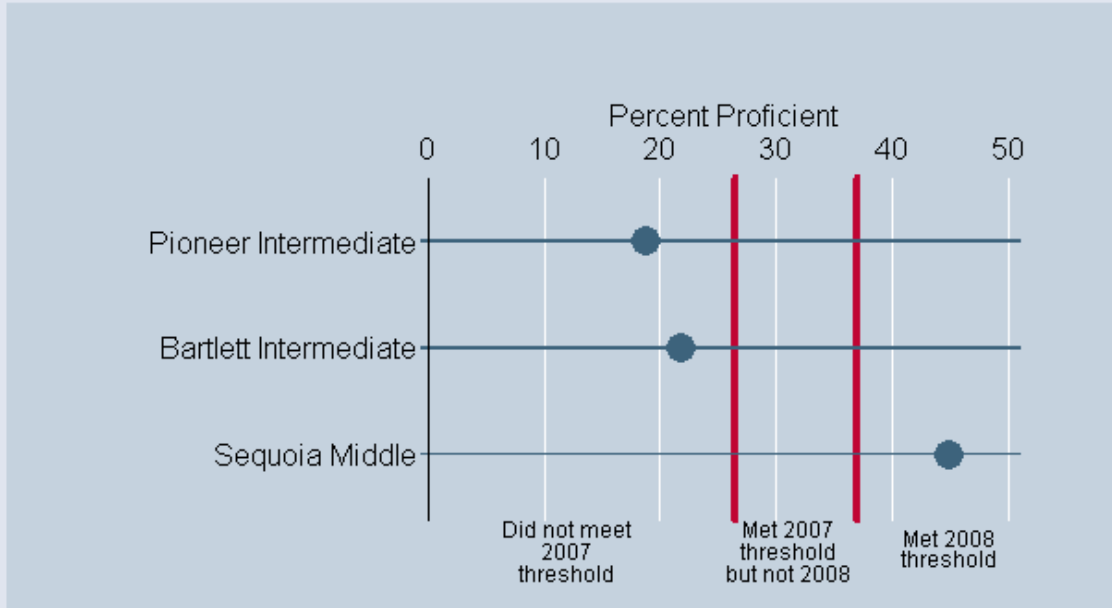

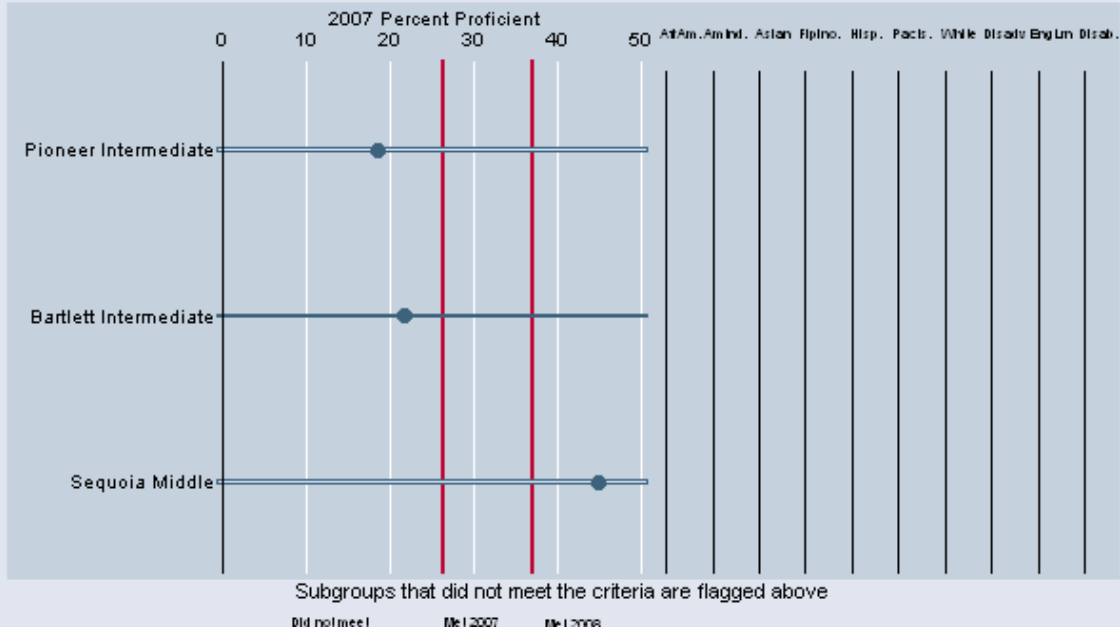
## Mathematics: Annual Measurable Objective 2007 Sunrise Unified, Middle Schools, All Students

In 2008, 37.0% of middle school students must score at the proficient level in Mathematics to comply with No Child Left Behind



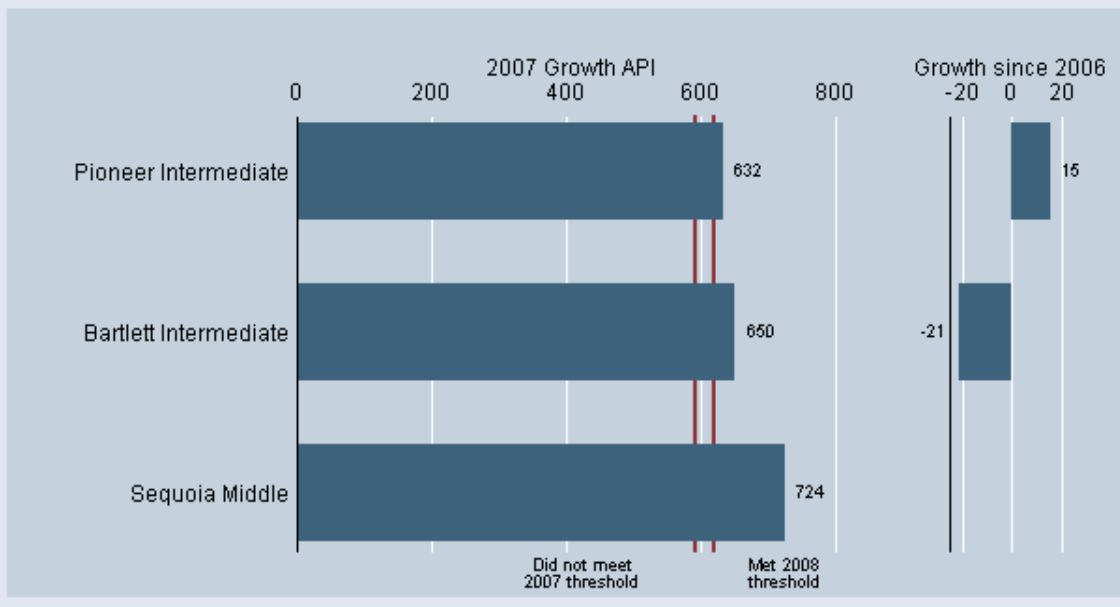
## Mathematics Percent Proficient 2007 Sunrise Unified, Middle Schools

To comply with No Child Left Behind in 2008, 35.2% of middle school students must score at the proficient level in Mathematics.



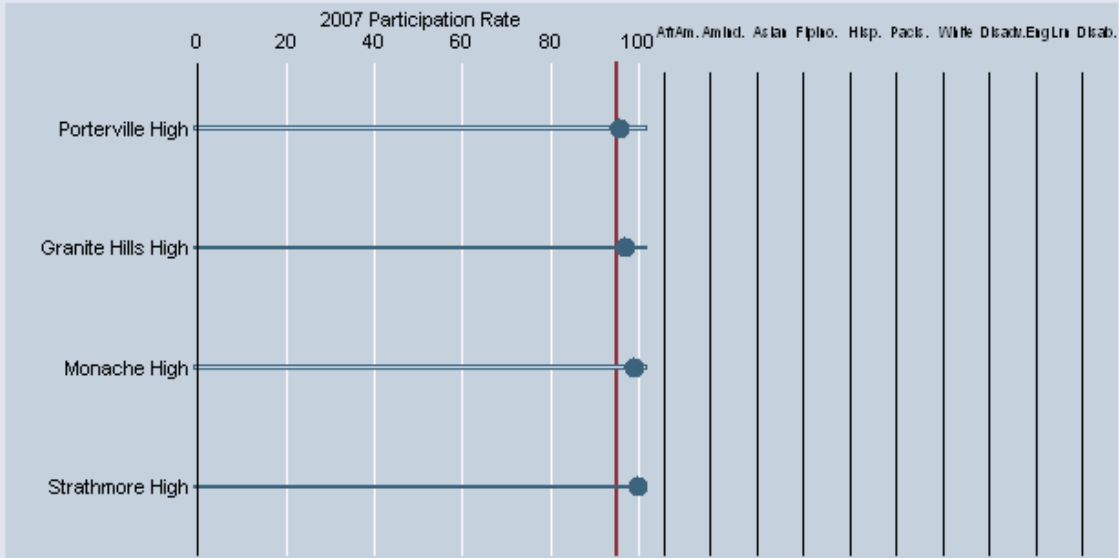

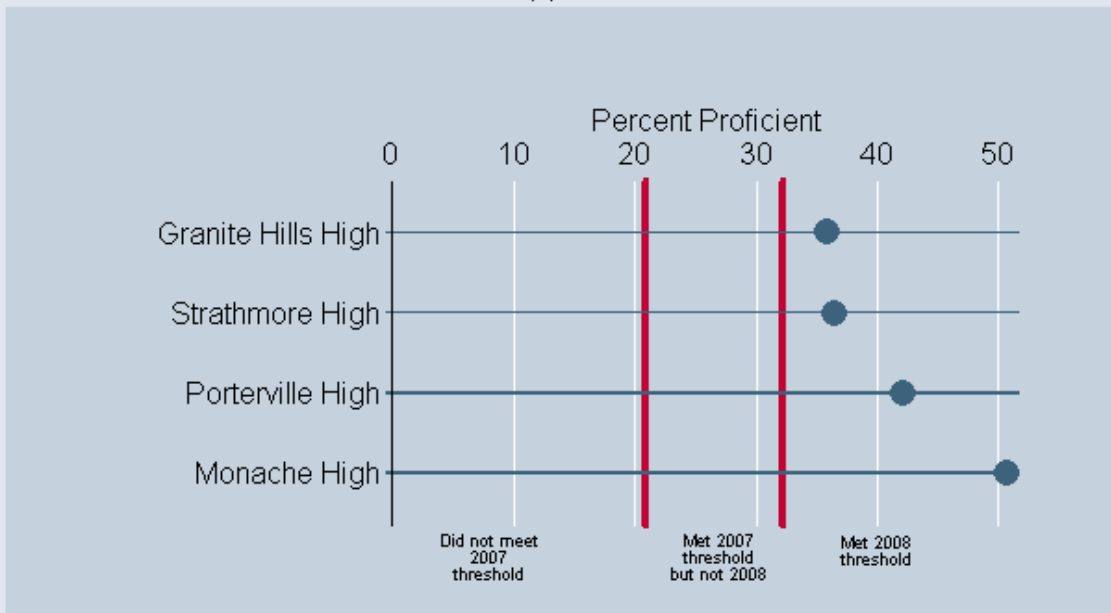

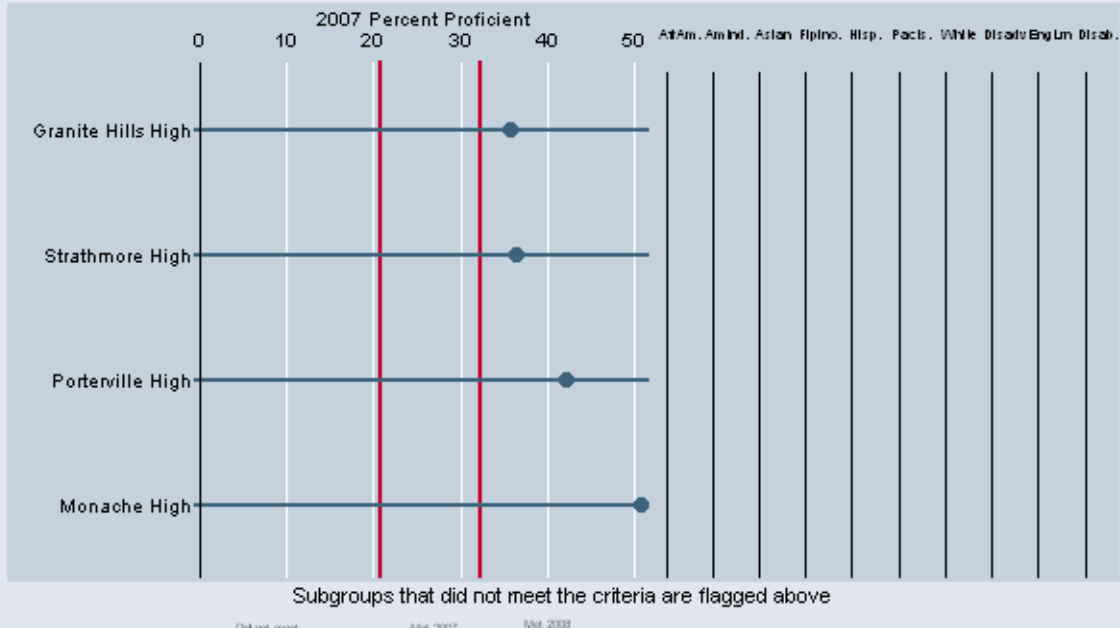
## Mathematics: Annual Measurable Objective 2007 Sunrise Unified, High Schools, All Students

## Mathematics Percent Proficient 2007 Sunrise Unified, High Schools

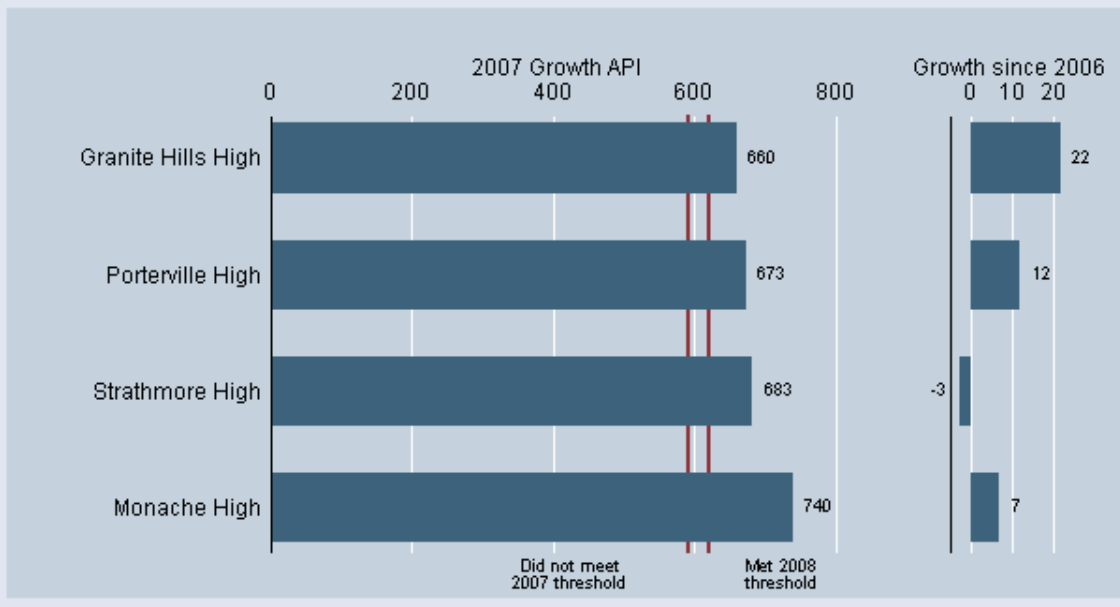
To comply with No Child Left Behind in 2008, 33.4% of high school students must score at the proficient level in Mathematics.

Under California's Public School Accountability Act, school APIs should be at least 800. To comply with No Child Left Behind, API scores must improve by one point each year or be at least 592 in 2007 and 620 in 2008.



## Graduation Rate 2007 Sunrise Unified, High Schools, All Students

To comply with No Child Left Behind, the graduation rate  
 (1) must be 82.9% or higher or  
 (2) show improvement since 2006 of at least 0.1 or  
 (3) show improvement in the average two-year graduation rate of at least 0.2.
